

Info and registration: League is run by Eagle Recreation. The cost is \$44 and includes a reversible Jersey. A minimum of 16 kids and 2 coaches are needed per age group A registration form and payment with check or cash via mail or drop box, or credit card online only, must be received by December 11, 2024 in order to play. All games and practices are held at Eagle Elementary Gym. Practice will begin second week of January and games will begin the 4th week of January for 6 weeks. Dates and times are subject to change. Refs will be provided at each game. Appropriate player and spectator etiquette is expected at all times.
